# SPOTSYLVANIA COUNTY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

## OFFICIAL CALL

### **Mass Meeting**

of Spotsylvania County Republican Committee  
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Spotsylvania County Republican Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Bryce Reeves, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Harrison Road Community Center, 4728 Harrison Road, Fredericksburg, VA, starting at 7:00 pm local time on March 26, 2009 for the purpose of electing delegates and an equal number of alternate delegates to the State Convention, to be held on May 29 - 30, 2009 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, 403 North Third St., Richmond, or its alternate site, starting at 2:00 p.m. local time, Friday, May 29, 2009. This meeting will be for: a) nominating a Republican candidate for Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General and, b) for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention. Each unit is entitled to one (1) delegate vote per (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Spotsylvania County Republican Committee is entitled to 169 delegate votes; and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

### Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Spotsylvania County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia as delegate candidates and in the Mass Meeting.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent. A single exception to the foregoing prohibition on participation shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future (the elements of this sentence shall be referred to as the "disaffiliation statement"). Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in Paragraph 3 thereafter.

### Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as state convention delegates at said mass meeting shall file a written statement by mail or in person, to Bryce Reeves, 11205 Gray Fox Pointe, Spotsylvania, VA 22551, which must be received not later than March 19, 2009 @ 5 PM. [*Note: a filing form is required and can be acquired on our website at [www.spotsygon.com](http://www.spotsygon.com) or contacting Chairman Bryce Reeves @ 540.226.1621.*] **Applicants need NOT attend the Mass Meeting on March 26, 2009 to be elected a delegate and/or alternate delegate to the Virginia Republican State Convention. However, participation in the mass meeting is encouraged.**

### Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.
