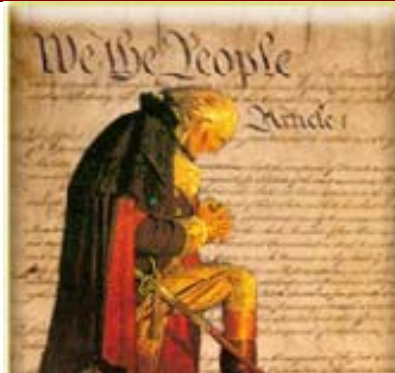

Institute on the Constitution (IOTC) is an educational effort sponsored by the Law Office of Peroutka and Peroutka of Pasadena, Maryland. It is neither an instrument of, nor an advocate for, any particular political party. Rather, they advocate the restoration of our Constitutional Republic by offering classes, lectures, and products designed to reacquaint the American people with our history, our heritage, and our Constitution, which is the very foundation of our Republic. You will not find smoke, mirrors, or political correctness filters at their presentations; just real American history, the way it was, the way it ought to be taught.

Let us, first of all, thank God for the freedoms that He has allowed us to retain and let's begin to recover the lost tools of self-government by learning about our place in His history. Let's learn the history of our own country, how our freedom from tyranny was won in God's Providence and how our Founding Fathers fashioned a plan for its preservation. The purpose of that plan was set forth in the Declaration of Independence in 1776 and the structure of that plan took the form of an agreement between the sovereign states known as the United States Constitution.

We need to study this profound document and the historical context in which it was written and adopted. We need, furthermore, to understand the religious and philosophical worldview of the drafters of this instrument and the clear intent of the States in ratifying a document that set forth the limited nature of the powers being vested in the federal government. We need to understand the Founders intent in adopting a Bill of Rights that acted as a check on the power of Congress and the Executive Authority from infringing the rights of the people from whom their authority was derived.

Regrettably but perhaps not surprisingly, the government schools have gradually lessened their emphasis on the teaching of American history and government. There seems to be a systematic and organized attempt to disconnect the youth of America from their heritage until at the present, although but a few generations from our founders, school children today have very little concept of the basic principles that their fathers fought and died to defend.

We hope that participants in this lecture series, working in small, local groups, and via the Internet, can begin the challenging, but rewarding and Godly task of restoring our lost freedoms. We further hope that participants in this study series, aided by study notes and other materials, will be able to pass on our Constitutional heritage to future generations of free Americans.

The Institute on the Constitution lecture series was formulated to provide a Constitutional education that is not taught in our schools. The IOTC offer a twelve session video program that explores the history and heritage of our Constitutional Republic, the philosophical and religious worldview of the framers, and a working knowledge of important Constitutional provisions. This course is designed to equip the people of America with knowledge that enables them to pass on the blessings of liberty to their posterity. The course features lectures by Dr. John Eidsmoe, Constitutional Law Professor of the Thomas Goode Jones School of Law at Faulkner University, Montgomery, Alabama. Also learn through other selected materials by speakers such as David Barton of Wallbuilders.
